Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Cemetery Fees – To be paid directly by the family to the Cemetery on the day of the interment.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Musician fees - Organist, Bagpipes, Soloist etc.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) Consumer Protection Fee The fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) in order to provide the consumer with information on the options within the bereavement sector and to regular the profession, making sure the law is consistently followed \$30.00

Payment and funding

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, or agreed upon, the contract amount must be paid at the time of the arrangements. Payment may be made by cash, cheque and most major credit cards.

Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets but must be discussed and agreed to by both parties at the time of making the arrangements.

Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5 % per month which is equivalent to 18 % per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing and monthly payments are also available.
